Safely dispose of unwanted, expired, or unused medications!

Please take these medications to a drop box to prevent harming others or the environment.



Keep medication in the original container and remove personal information.

To properly dispose of needles, place them in a puncture proof container (milk jug or laundry detergent jug) and tape the lid with duct tape. Then, it can be tossed in the trash.





To dispose of liquid medications, pour them into a sealable plastic bag or can. Add coffee grounds or cat litter to the bag and then toss in the trash.

Unused medications left insecure in the home can lead to accidental poisonings or prescription drug abuse. It is important to properly and safely dispose of medication. Flushing medication down the toilet can lead to harmful effects on our water systems!
